**MISCELLANEOUS CONTROLS (IMPORTATION AND  
EXPORTATION OF GOODS) (PROHIBITION) (RADIOACTIVE  
MATERIALS) REGULATIONS, 2004**

**Authority :** These Regulations were made on 14th December, 2004 by the Minister under section 3(2) of the *Miscellaneous Controls Act*.

**Commencement:** 30th December, 2004.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Miscellaneous Controls (Importation and Exportation of Goods) (Prohibition) (Radioactive Materials) Regulations, 2004*.
2. No person shall, except under the authority of a licence granted by the Minister, import into Barbados
  - (a) any goods specified in the *Schedule*; or
  - (b) any goods referred to in paragraph (a) that are intransit or in transshipment to any country.
3. No person shall, except under the authority of a licence granted by the Minister, export from Barbados
  - (a) any goods specified in the *Schedule*; or
  - (b) any goods referred to in paragraph (a) with intent to tranship or cause the goods to be transhipped to any country.
4. The licence referred to in paragraph 2 or 3 may be subject to such conditions as the Minister may specify in the licence.

**5.** Any person who imports or exports any goods in contravention of these Regulations is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$20 000 or to imprisonment for a term of 2 years; and the goods may be forfeited.
